GREEN PROTOCOL

1. Inspire students to use bags, purses made of cloth, pencil boxes to reduce rexine waste.

3. Avoid use of plastic covering and rexine binding on project records and reports.
4. Avoid the use of the printed material.
5. Encourage the use of e-copies on the campus.
6. Welcome the dignitaries with a single flower or a sapling during functions by avoiding the complete use of bouquets wrapped in plastic covers.
7. Encourage jute paper files and pencils and avoid plastic files and pens.
8. Make use of utensils that can be washed and reused and avoid all disposable items on the campus.
9. Avoid the use of plastic carry bags on the campus.
10. Separate the waste generated into biodegradable non- biodegradable and hazardous categories.

11. Avoid burning plastic and papers by handing them over to scrap dealers.
12. Hand over the stored electrical and electronic waste for proper recycling.
13. Minimize the use of paper.
14. Display reminders in every room including bathroom, washroom to turn off lights and fans when not in use.
15. Constitute Green committee to create awareness about green practices among the students.
16. Conduct green awareness sessions for students, faculties and office employees.
17. Encourage students to use and promote LED bulbs.
18. Installed LED bulbs in the classrooms and laboratories.
19. Popularize the use of bags made of cloth.
20. Carry out Cleanliness drive, Swachhata Abhiyaan etc.
21. Observe all important environmental days.
22. Create awareness about the environment among the people in the society.
23. Support local governments, civic bodies in carrying out green initiatives.
24. Extend hearty support to the green initiatives of the Government of Maharashtra and Central Government of India.
